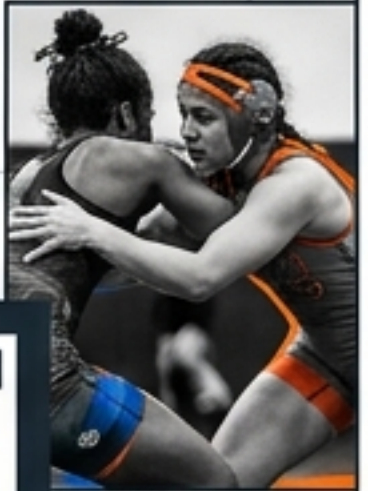
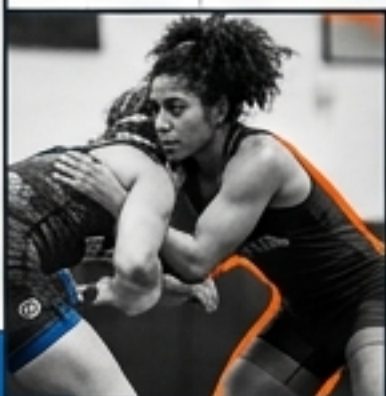

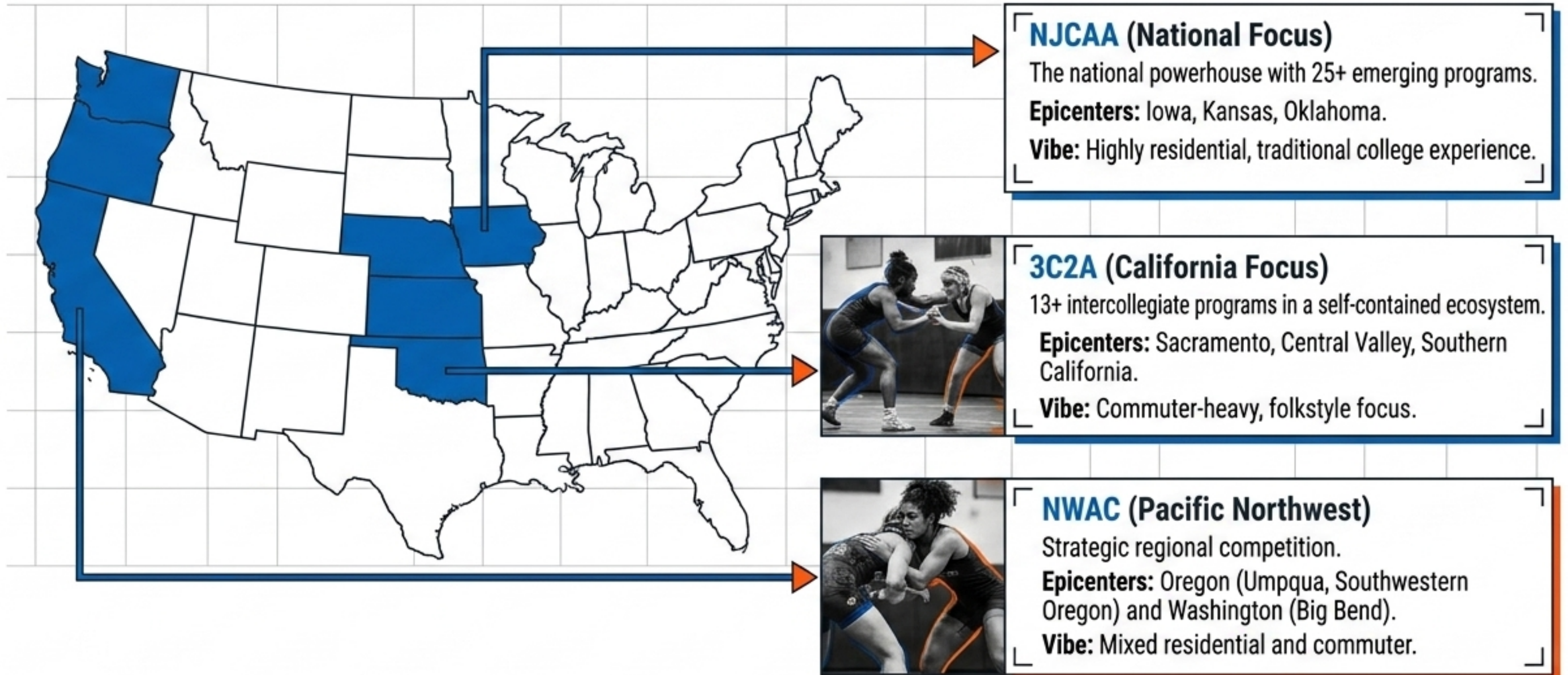

Governing Bodies Dictate Regional Ecosystems and Transfer Rules



The Daily Environment is Dictated by Three Distinct Housing Models



Model 1: The Mini-University (Residential JC)

Out-of-state rural and plains campuses. Traditional dormitories, mandatory dining hall meal plans, and a highly self-contained campus life.



Model 2: The Commuter Athlete (Local CC)

Prevalent in urban centers and the California 3C2A ecosystem. Athletes live at home or rent local apartments. High independence, maximum budget optimization.



Model 3: The Hybrid & Partnership (Creative Solutions)

Unique campus exceptions and university partnerships. Features seamless shuttle systems or rare on-campus exceptions in otherwise commuter zones.

STRATEGIC DIRECTIVE: Where you choose to wrestle dictates how you will live. Evaluate the housing model before evaluating the roster.

The Residential Junior College Mirrors a Traditional Four-Year Experience

Snow College (UT)

\$1,400 - \$2,170

Per semester. Features cooking apartments, fully furnished living spaces, and free WiFi. Ideal for independent campus living.

Carl Albert State (OK)

\$2,650

Per semester. Includes double-occupancy housing and a mandatory 16-week campus meal plan. Operates the Scholars Center.

Southeast CC (NE)

14 to 19

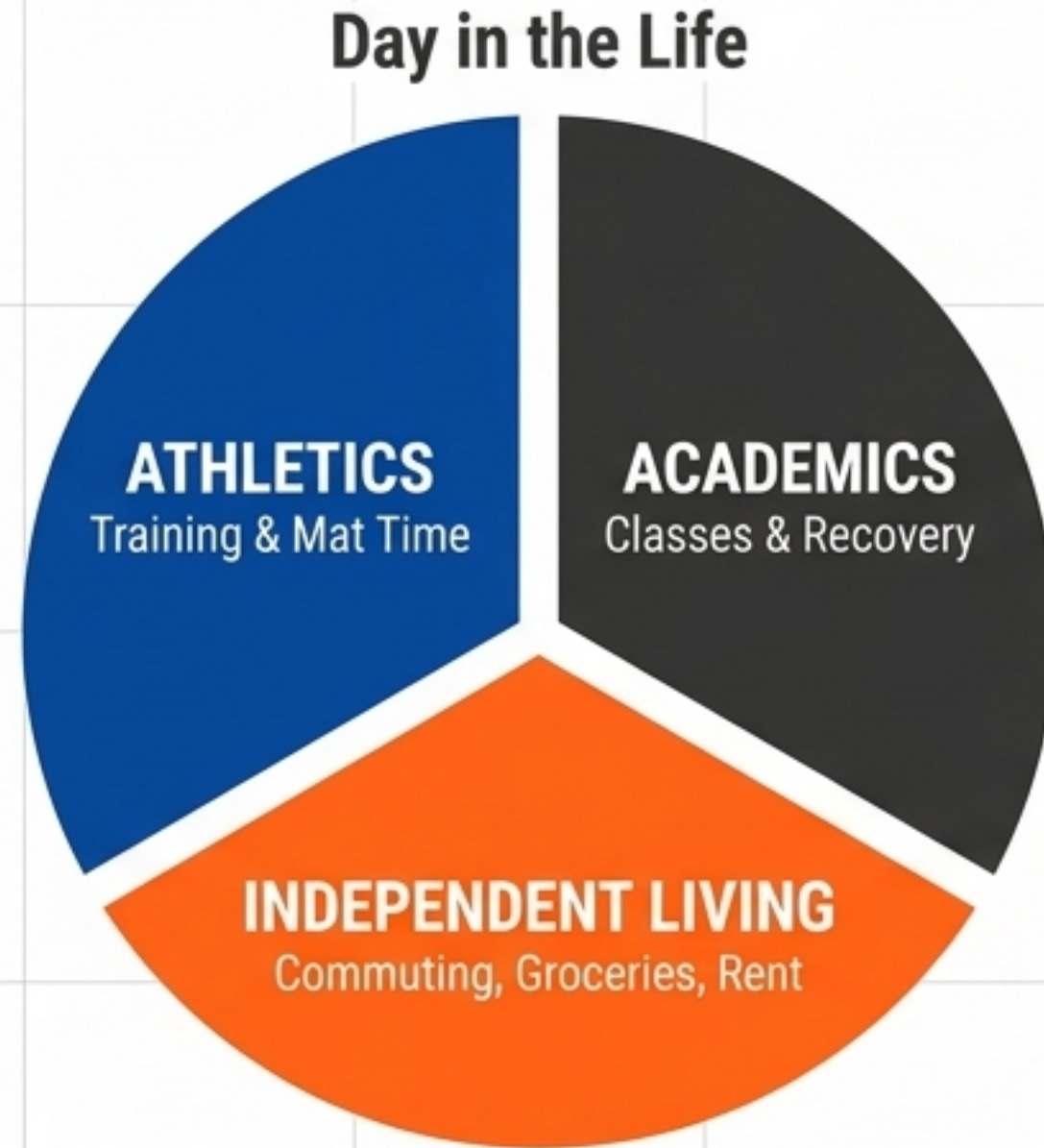
Meals per week options. Beatrice, Lincoln, and Milford campuses offer a highly integrated college life. Meningococcal immunization required.

Lackawanna (PA)

191 Beds

Across traditional structures: Seeley Hall (111 co-ed beds) and Tobin Hall (80 co-ed beds). Commuters not living at home must reside on campus.

Commuter Campuses Require Budget Optimization and Independent Living



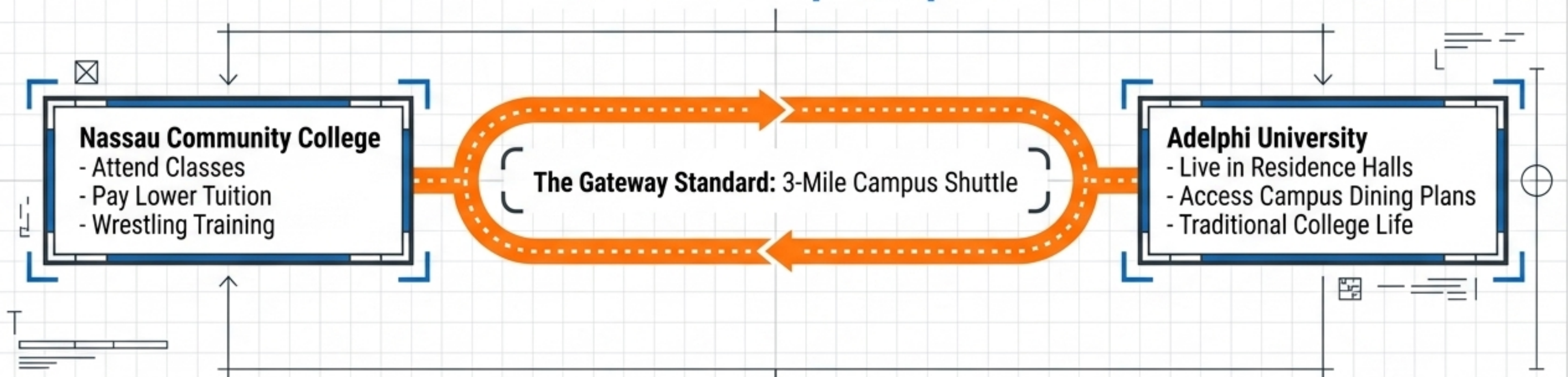
The 3C2A Reality

Powerhouses like Bakersfield, Cerritos, Mt. SAC, and Fresno City are predominantly commuter campuses. Athletes form "Team Houses," acting as independent tenants rather than dorm residents. This structure requires high personal responsibility but offers massive tuition savings for local residents.

The On-Campus Exceptions

Some rare California community colleges break the commuter rule by offering dedicated dormitories, serving for out-of-area athletes. Examples Lassen College (Victor St. Marie Residence Hall), Coalinga College, and College of the Redwoods.

Four Crucial Questions to Ask During the Recruiting Intake Process



1. Governance & Transfer

Do you compete in the NJCAA, 3C2A, or NWAC, and how does that impact my specific 4-year transfer timeline?



2. The Housing Reality

Are campus dorms guaranteed for athletes, or am I responsible for securing an off-campus lease?



4. Academic Alignment

Do your two-year degree pathways map directly to my intended major at my target 4-year transfer university?



3. Nutritional Support

Is a 14-to-19 meal plan provided, or will I need to budget for my own groceries and daily cooking?
