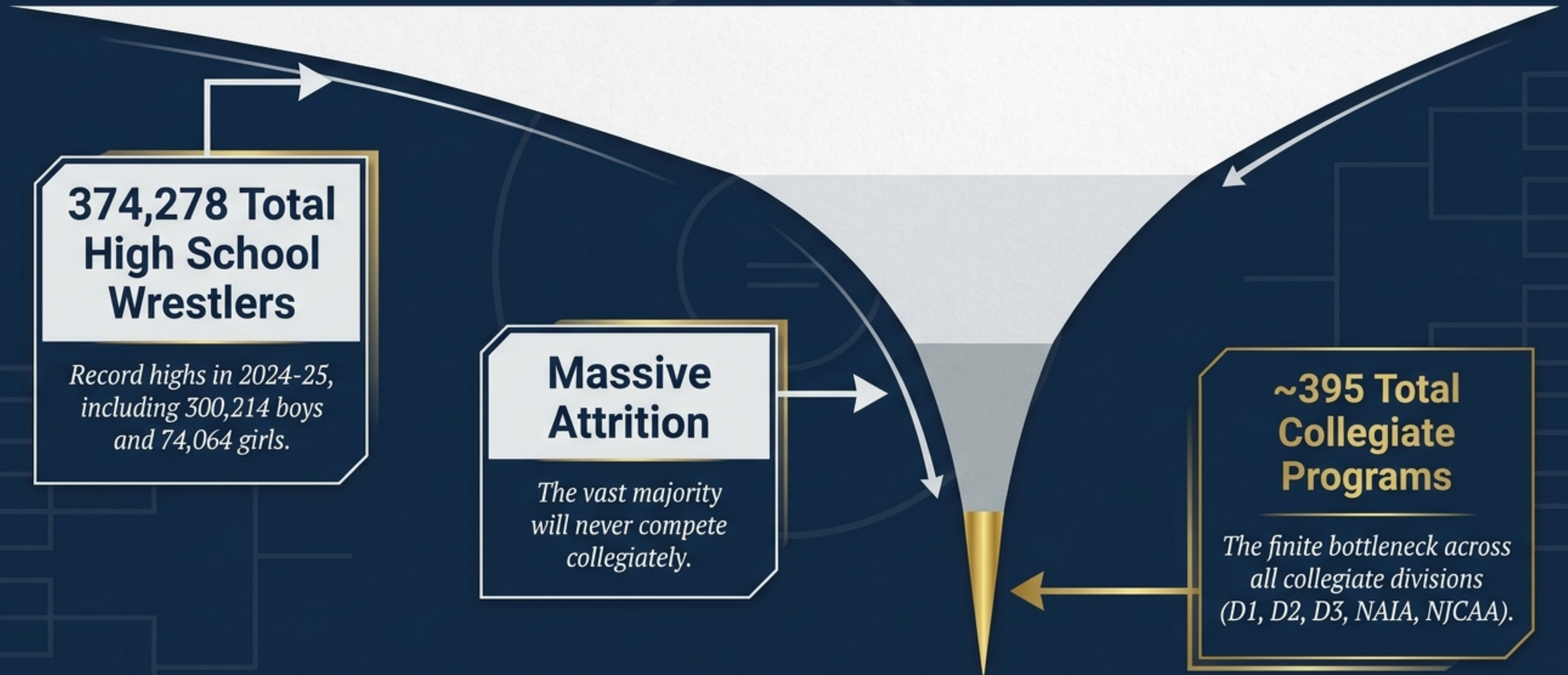


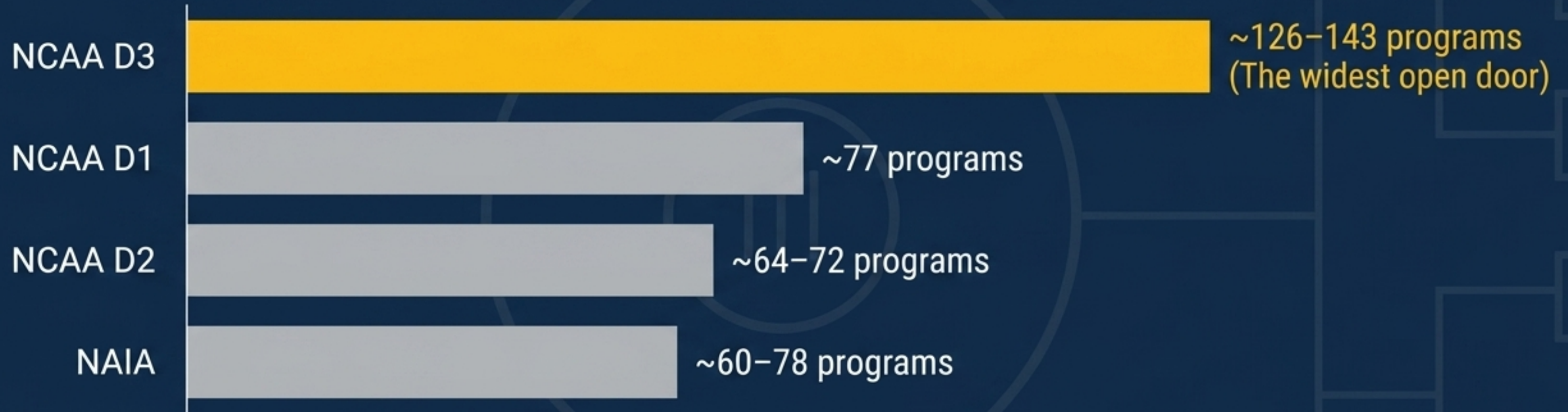

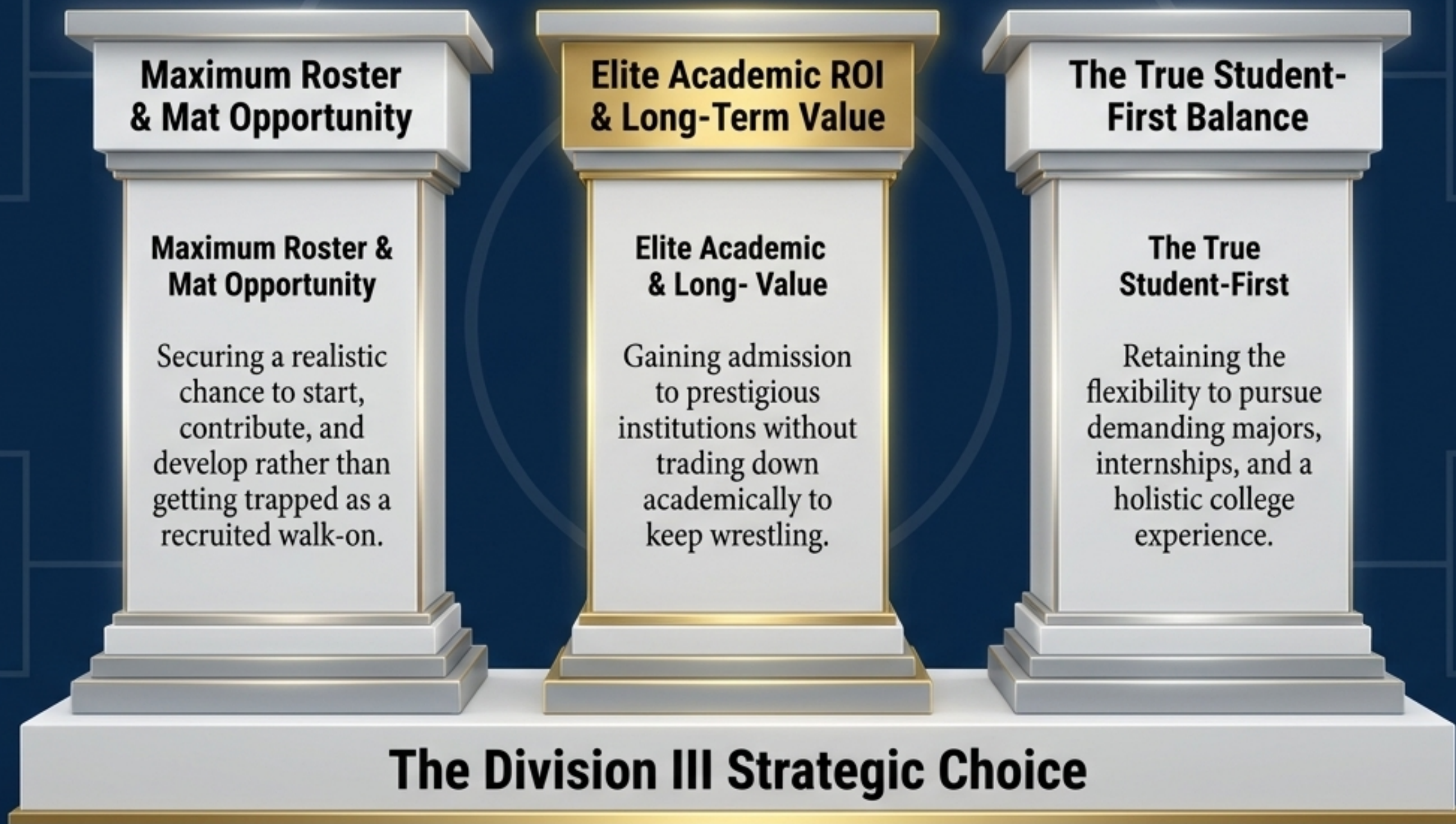


Where the Roster Opportunities Actually Live

The Collegiate Division Diagnostic Matrix

Shifted from the old 9.9 equivalency model to strict new roster limits. Creates intense roster churn, minimal security for walk-ons, and highly professionalized year-round demands.	Capped at ~9 equivalency scholarships. Heavy athletic focus with aid heavily fractured across the starting lineup.	Capped at ~8 equivalency scholarships. Flexible rules but fewer overall programs and high reliance on fractured partial aid.	Uncapped institutional merit and need-based aid. Zero athletic strings attached. Roster stability built on a student-first architecture.

The Reality



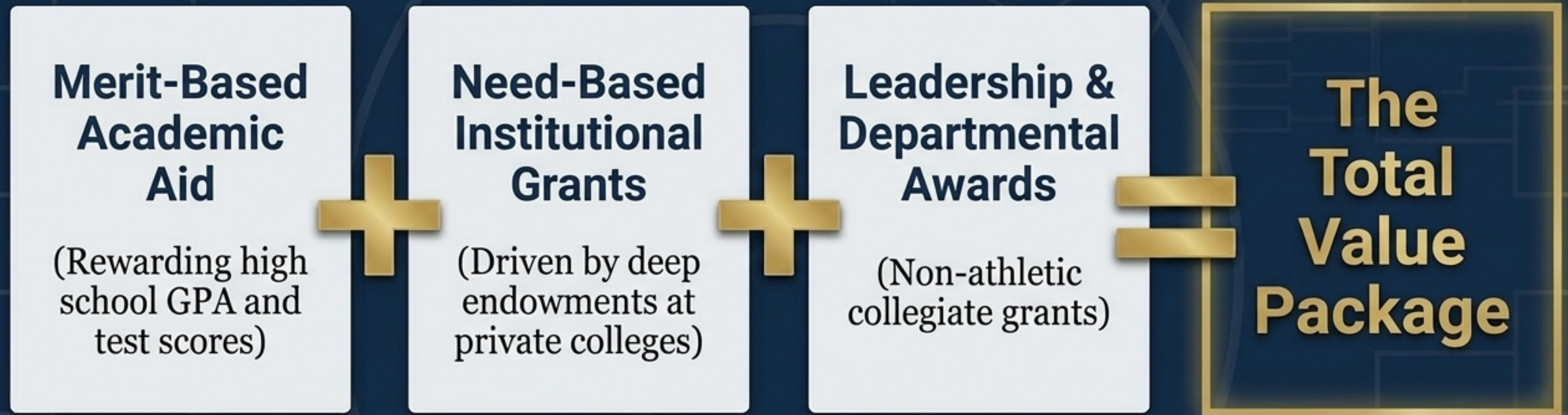
Full rides are **exceedingly rare** outside D1 **blue-bloods**.

Most non-D1 wrestlers receive partial scholarships, fractured across large rosters.

These partial packages are constantly leveraged against performance, weight-class necessities, coaching turnover, and injuries.

Your funding is tied directly to your utility on the mat.

The Division III Financial Aid Equation



Over **80%** of D3 student-athletes receive significant institutional aid. For a strong student, this uncapped academic package frequently surpasses the net value of a fractured, partial athletic scholarship at a D2 or NAIA program.

The D1/D2 Compromise

Year-round, professionalized training obligations often force athletes to abandon demanding academic tracks.

D3 rooms are filled with former state champions, placers, and elite competitors. The skill gap at the top is razor-thin.



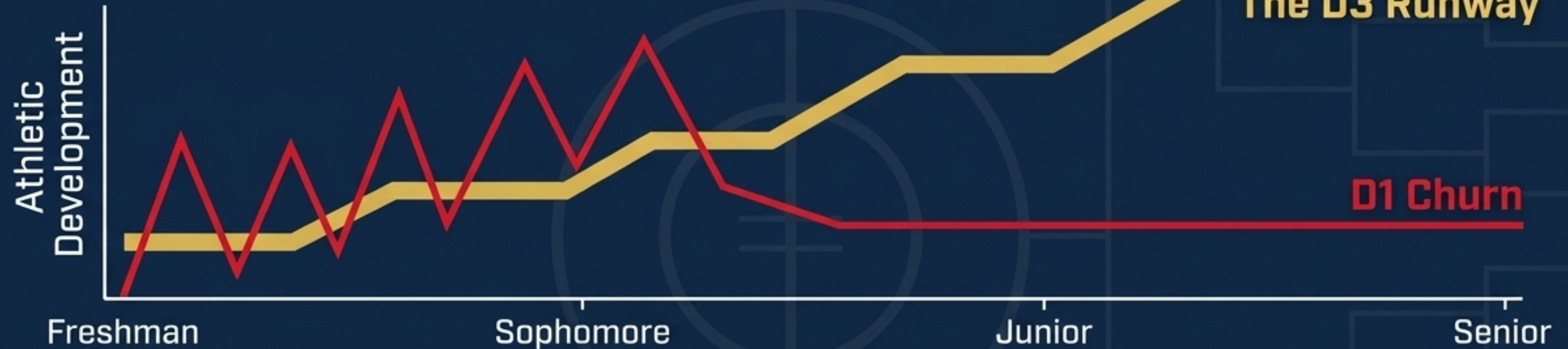
Championship Pedigree

Institutional Caliber

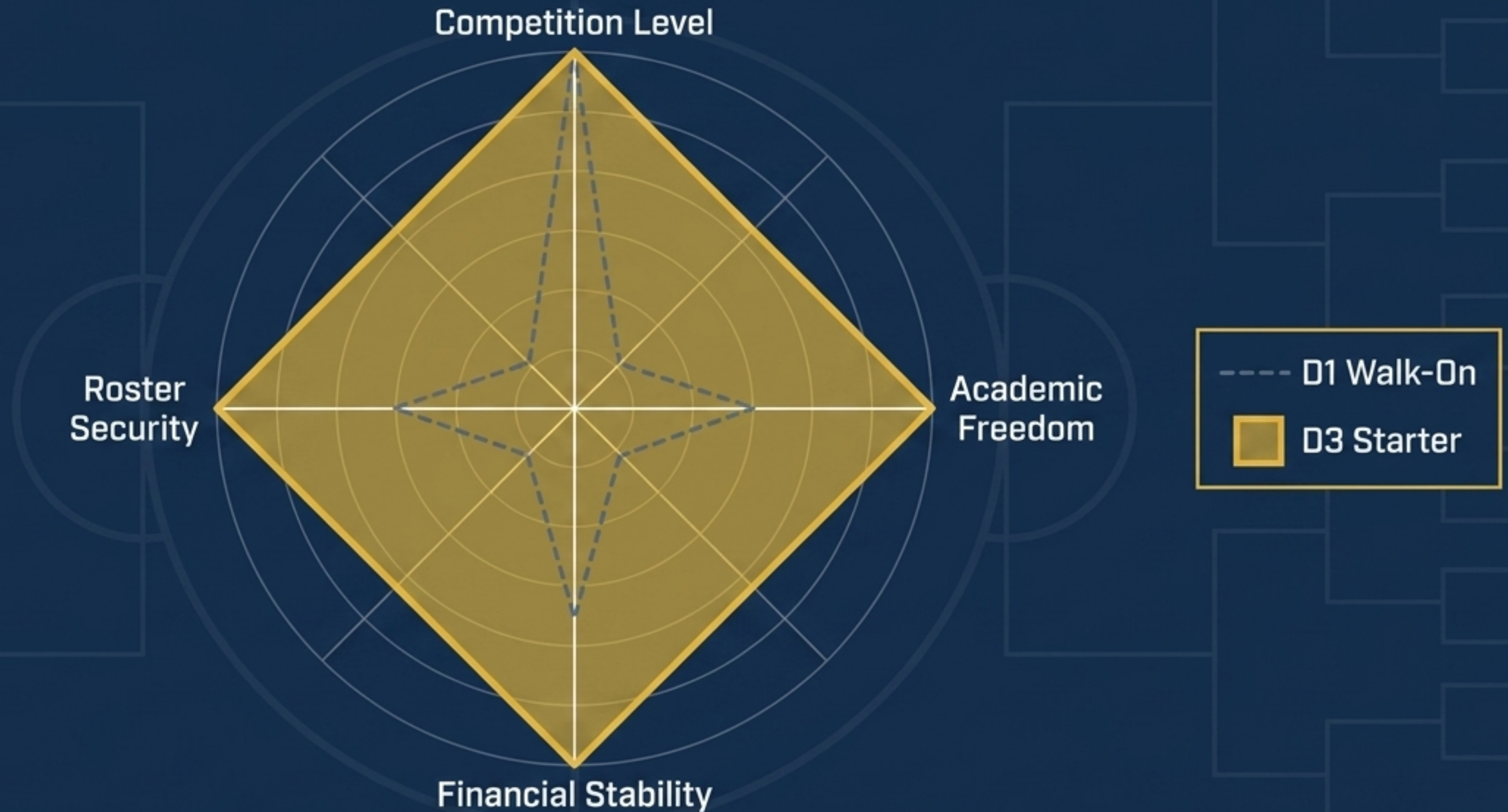
Programs exist at globally recognized academic powerhouses including Johns Hopkins, University of Chicago, MIT, NYU, and heavily endowed private colleges.
