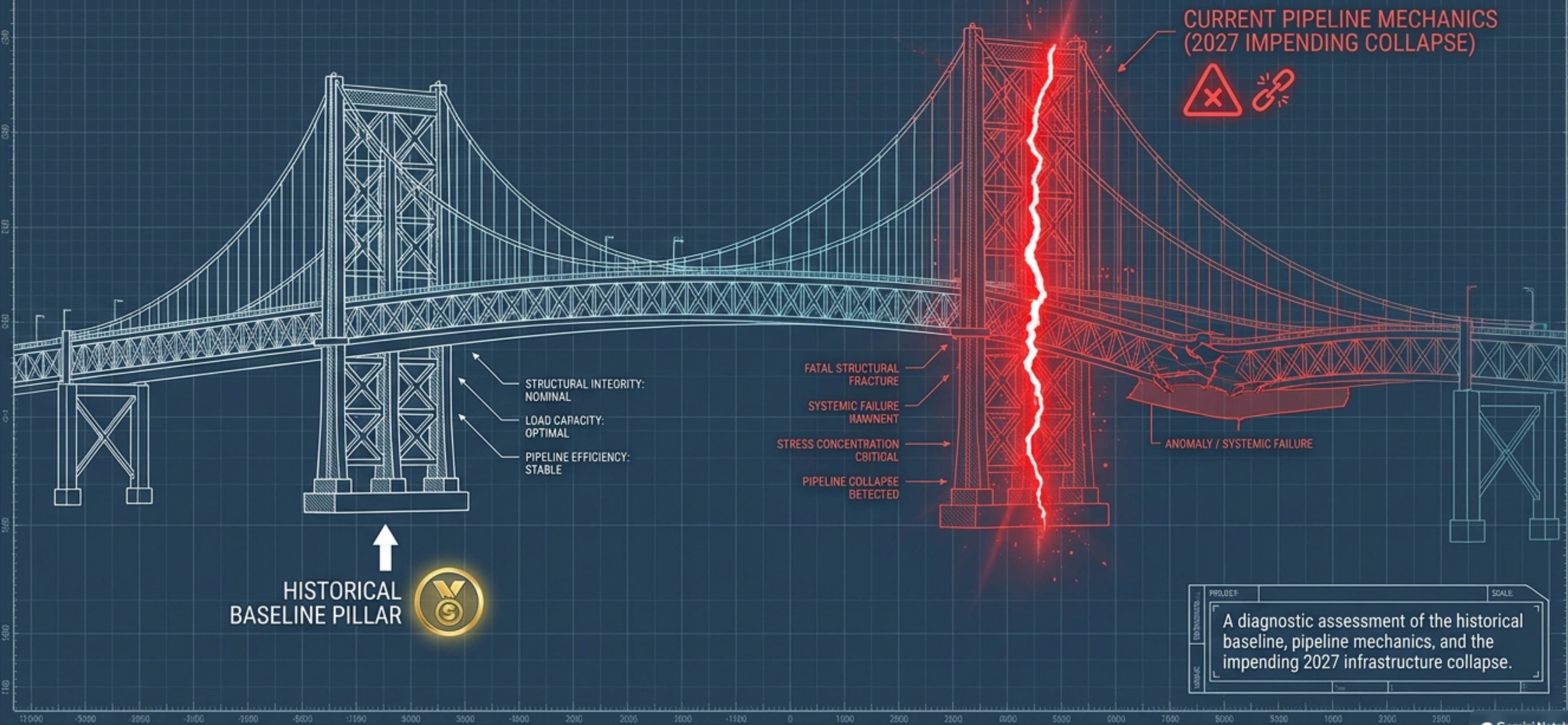

FREESTYLE (COLLEGIATE HOST SYSTEM)



GRECO-ROMAN (STANDALONE SYSTEM)

FEEDER INSTITUTIONS

~400-500 combined NCAA, NAIA, NJCAA, and NCWA programs.

Zero collegiate varsity host programs.

SCHOLARSHIP MARKET

Utilizes NCAA/NAIA full and partial rides.

No varsity scholarships **specifically dedicated** to the style.

TALENT FUNNEL

Established collegiate recruiting network evaluating high school folkstyle.

Relies on self-selection at Cadet/Junior/U23 national events.

FULL-TIME TRAINING

Dozens of Division I wrestling rooms and multiple RTCs.

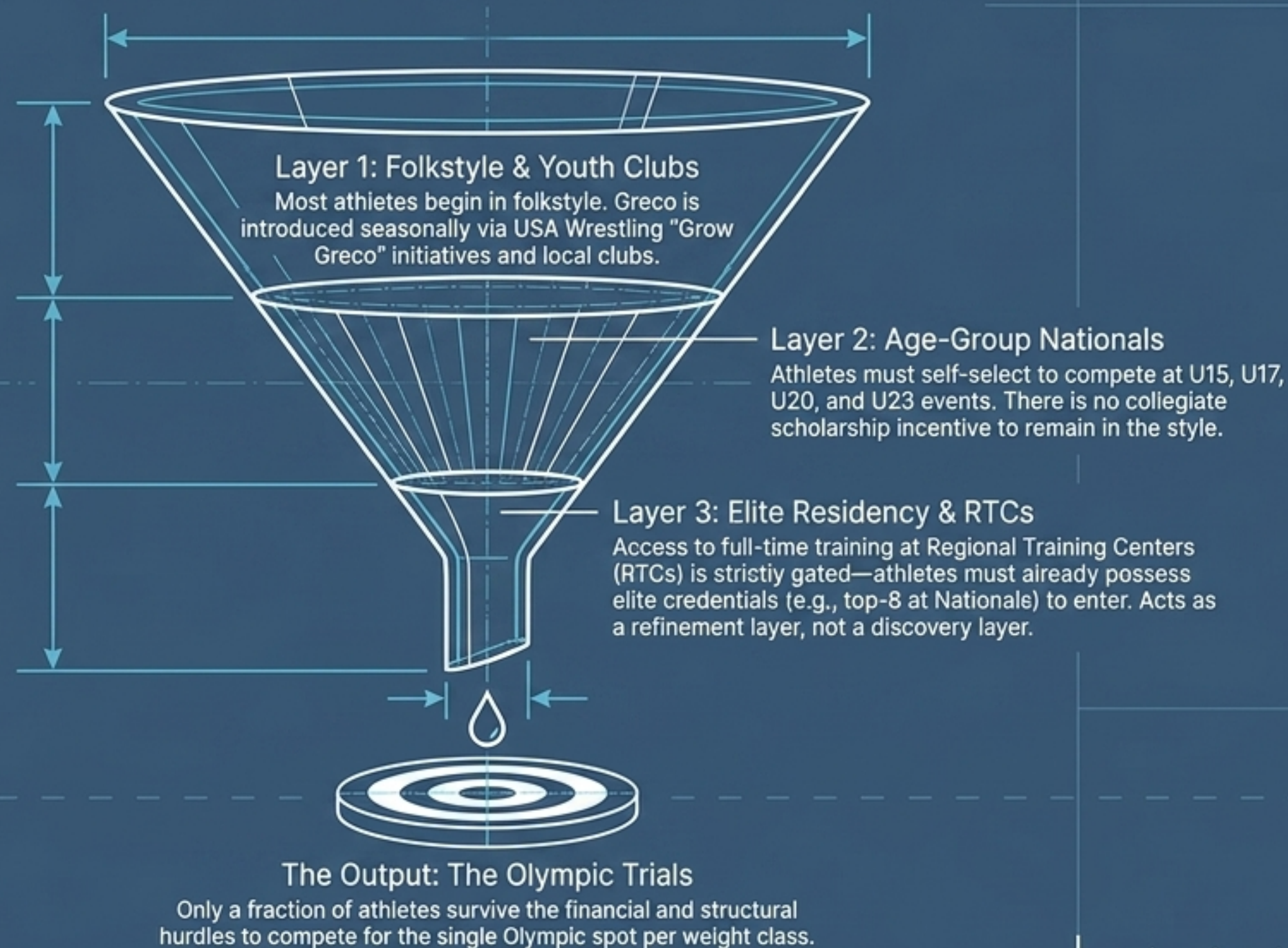
Relies almost entirely on Army WCAP and a single resident site.

OLYMPIC PRODUCTION

59 Olympic golds.

3 all-time Olympic golds.

Without a collegiate recruiting engine, athletes must survive a highly gated developmental funnel.



Senior-level survival relies entirely on two distinct institutional archetypes.

Army WCAP

(The State-Supported Professional Model)



LOCATION:

- Fort Carson, CO (est. 1997).

MECHANISM:

- Soldier-athletes receive enlisted pay, housing, and healthcare in exchange for military service and full-time training.

IMPACT:

- The dominant Greco house in the U.S. (produced 5 of the 10 athletes on the 2023 Senior World Team).

NMU NTS

(The Collegiate Resident Model)



LOCATION:

- Marquette, MI (Olympic lineage dating to 1985).

MECHANISM:

- The only site in the U.S. pairing elite Greco-Roman residency training with a university degree path.

IMPACT:

- Served as the crucial developmental bridge for 18-22-year-olds transitioning out of high school who do not immediately join the military.

The 1984 Soviet boycott heavily masks the true historical baseline of U.S. Olympic success.



The 1984 Anomaly

The Soviet Union and Eastern Bloc superpowers boycotted the Los Angeles Games. In this depleted field, the U.S. won 4 medals (including 2 golds by Steve Fraser and Jeff Blatnick).

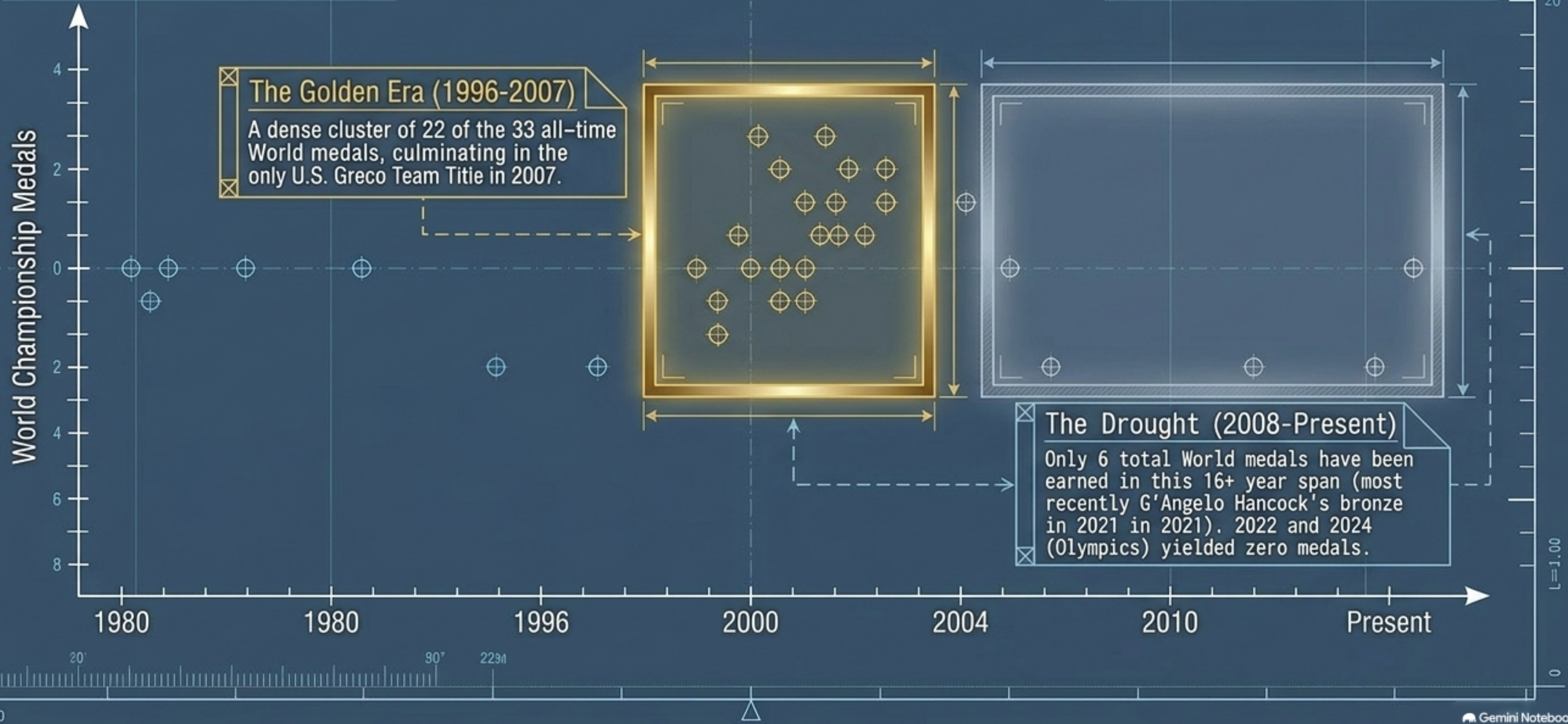
The Mathematical Reality

This single boycotted Games accounts for ~29% of every Olympic Greco-Roman medal the U.S. has won in its history, and 2 of its 3 all-time golds.

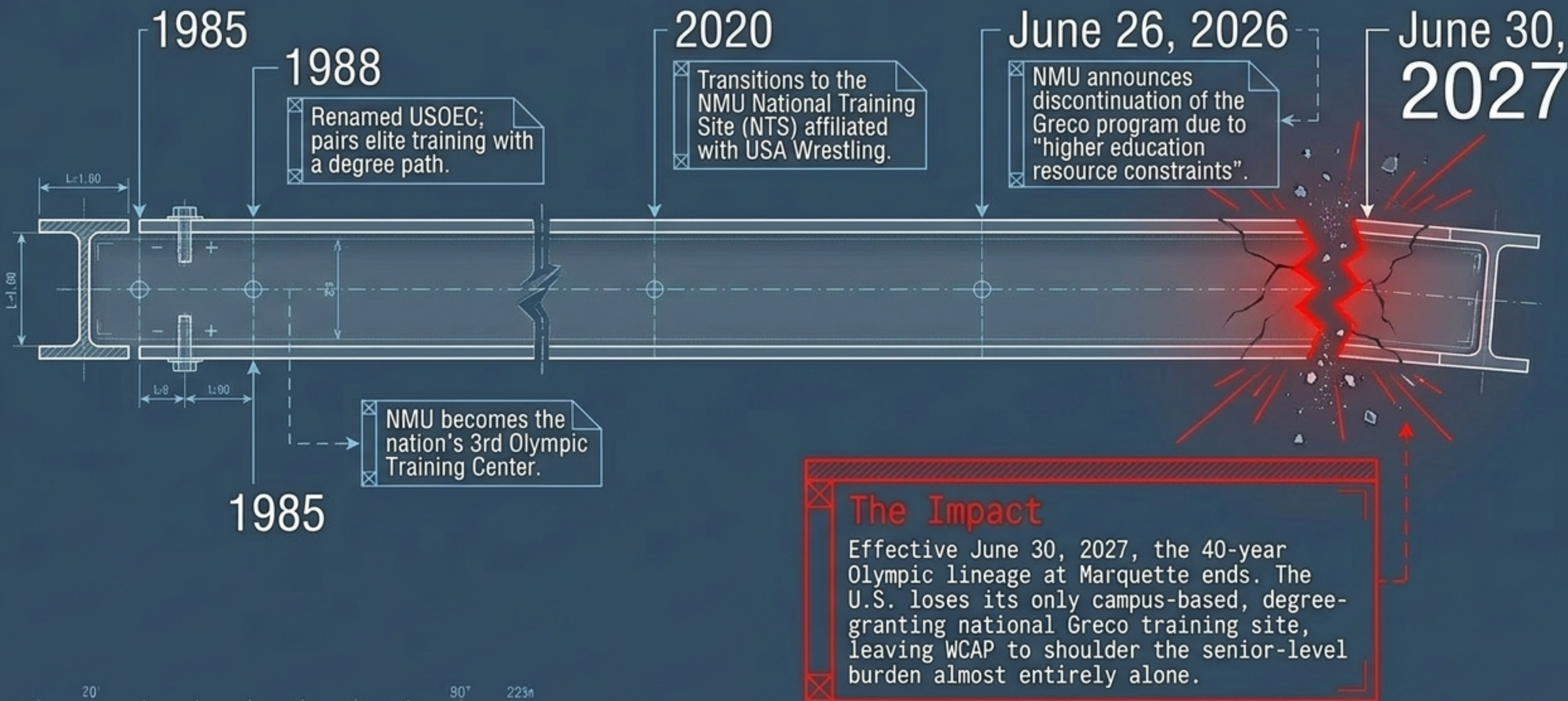
The True Baseline

Outside of 1984, the U.S. has won just 10 medals across 10 non-boycotted Games since 1972 (with Rulon Gardner's 2000 upset marking the only gold against a fully fielded Russian program).

Systemic production effectively collapsed after 2008, leaving a massive medal drought.



The scheduled 2027 closure of the NMU Training Site creates an immediate structural collapse.



Surviving the collapse requires engineering a new collegiate-resident pillar.

Rebuilding the Blueprint

The Surviving Ecosystem:

The U.S. retains military dominance (WCAP) and gated refinement centers (RTCs), but lacks the connective tissue.

USAW Grassroots/RTCs

WCAP Professional

The Critical Void:

The system now lacks a subsidized developmental hub for 18-22-year-olds who require full-time Greco training while pursuing a civilian college degree.

Elite Accelerator Program

The Mandate:

Strategic investment cannot simply fund individual athletes; **it must build a new structural pillar to replace the collegiate-resident model lost at NMU.** Without a structural replacement, the post-2008 medal drought will become permanent.
