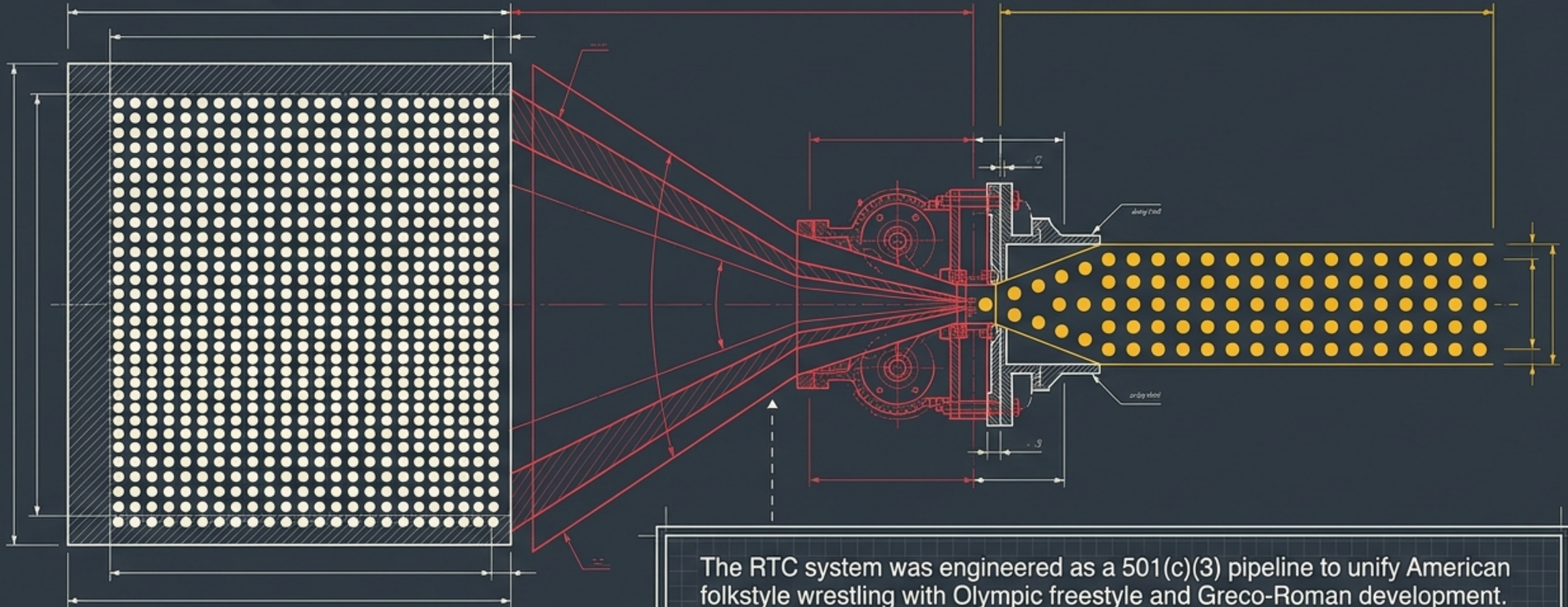

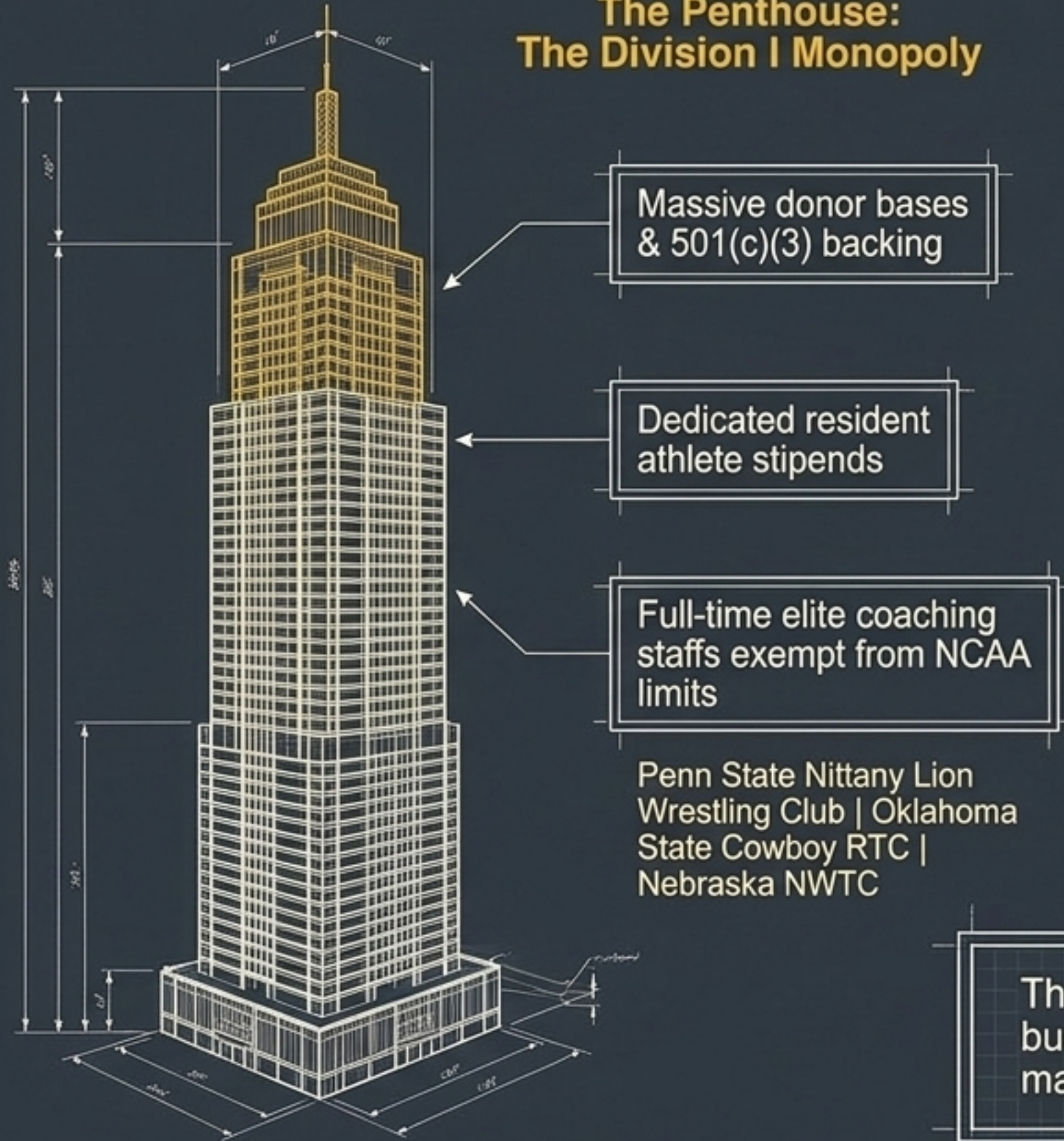

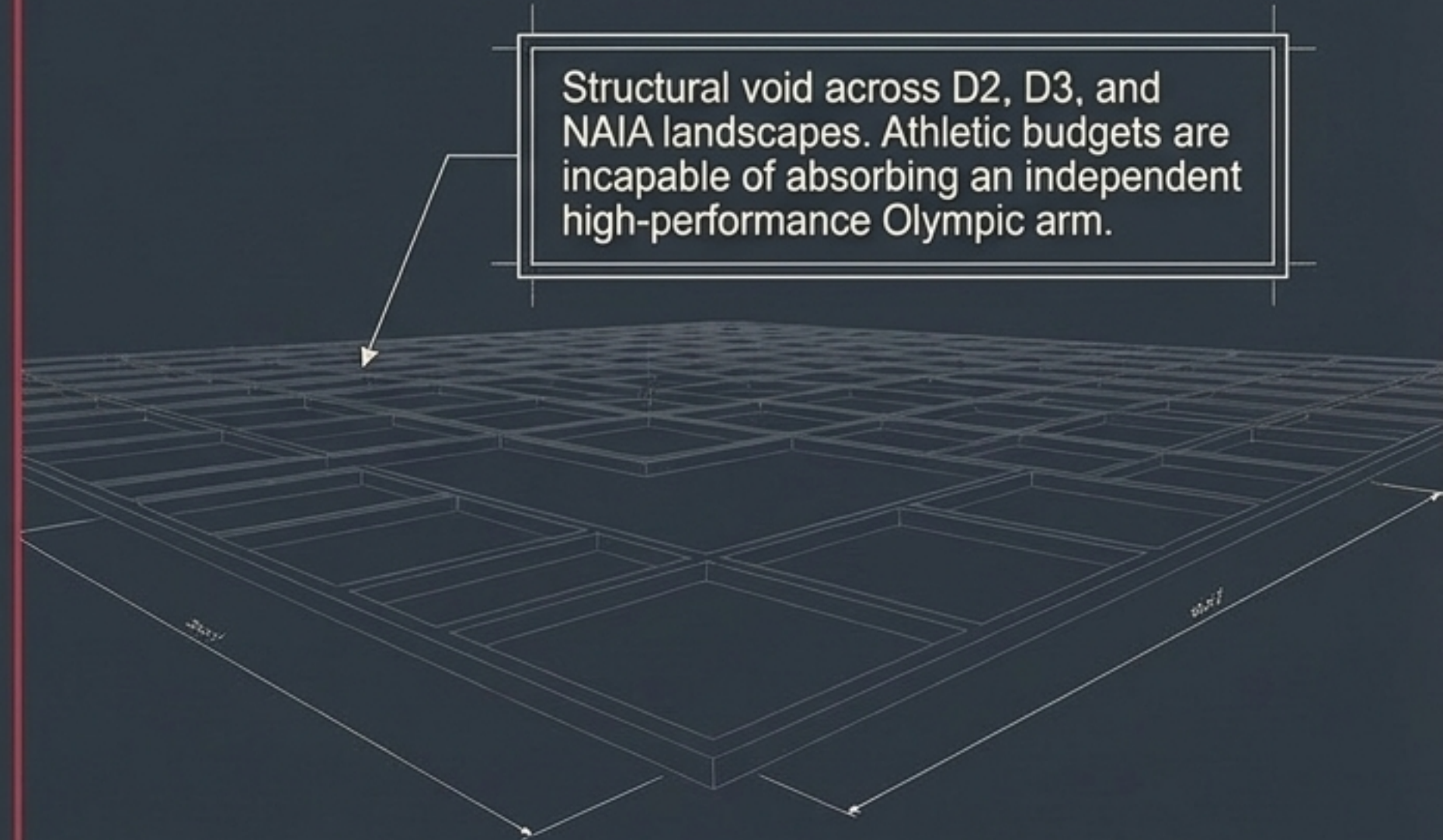


The RTC system was engineered as a 501(c)(3) pipeline to unify American folkstyle wrestling with Olympic freestyle and Greco-Roman development. Yet, it operates as an extreme bottleneck. Over 93% of collegiate ecosystems lack a direct, localized bridge to senior-level international development.

The Penthouse: The Division I Monopoly

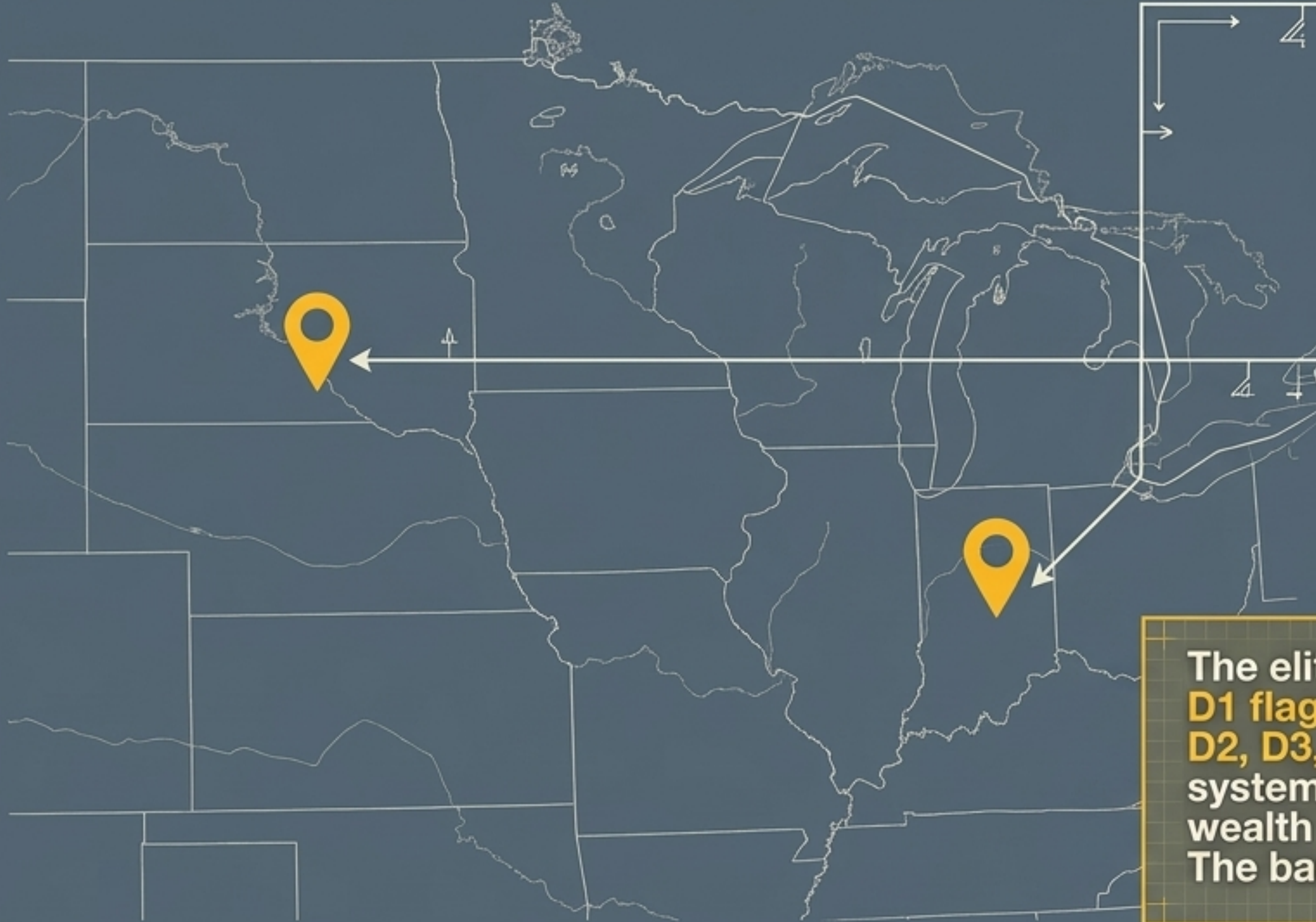


The Empty Rooms: The Underserved Majority



The RTC ecosystem relies almost exclusively on Power Conference budgets and local wealth, creating an arms race that isolates the vast majority of the collegiate landscape from the Olympic pipeline.

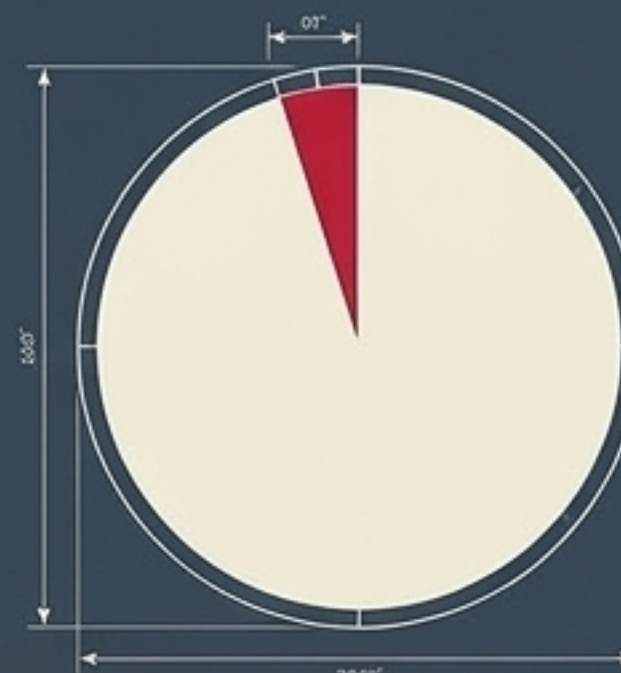
Sustaining an elite training environment at the Division II level in Aberdeen, SD.

The elite training model is **replicable below the D1 flagship tier**. These localized hubs prove that **D2, D3, and NAIA programs** can host RTCs when systemic focus shifts from mere institutional wealth to true regional development. The barrier is **priority, not structural impossibility**.

Scheduled discontinuation of the Northern Michigan University (NMU) Olympic Training Site due to higher-education resource constraints.

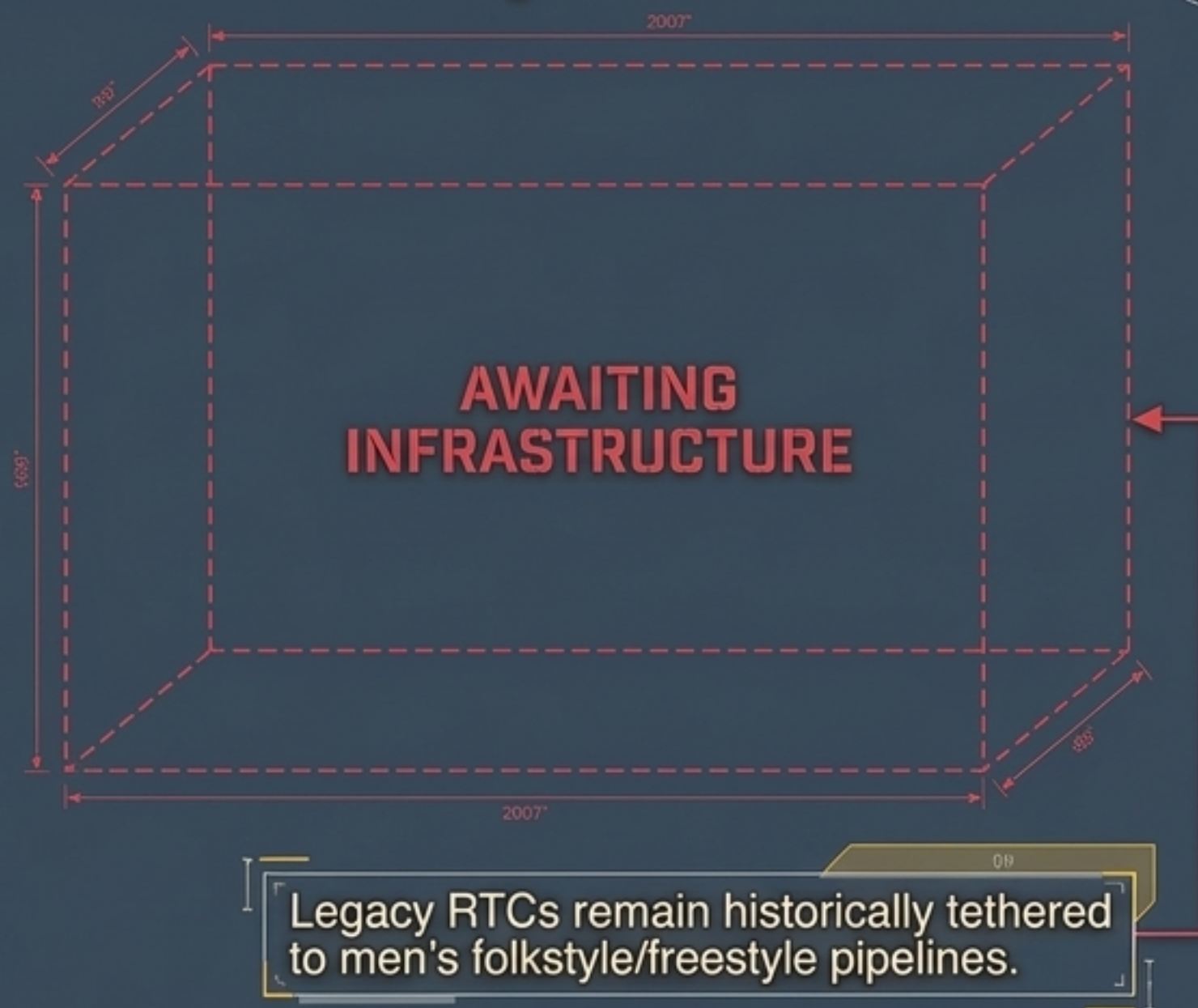
The Collapsing Pillar. NMU represents the only dedicated collegiate Greco-Roman pipeline in the United States. With RTCs overwhelmingly prioritizing the folkstyle-to-freestyle transition, the closure of NMU threatens a localized extinction event for American Greco-Roman development.

The Women's Wrestling Structural Gap



Explosive, unprecedented growth of collegiate women's wrestling.

The Unbuilt Wing. As women's wrestling surges nationwide, establishing dedicated, heavily funded **Women's Freestyle RTCs** is not merely an expansion—it is a **missing foundational pillar** required for international dominance.



Legacy RTCs remain historically tethered to men's folkstyle/freestyle pipelines.

Resource allocation reveals a fractured system.

The 'RTC' label creates a facade of uniformity, serving only a fraction of the emproppment of the American wrestling demographic.

Synthesis & The Blueprint for Expansion



01

Scale the Lower-Division Model

Actively charter and fund RTC outposts at D2, D3, and NAIA institutions to decentralize elite coaching.

03

Construct the Women's Pillar

Direct specific, earmarked 501(c)(3) capital toward year-round, resident-capacity Women's Freestyle RTCs.



To secure international dominance, USA Wrestling must transform the RTC system from an exclusive Division I penthouse into a **truly national, multi-style, multi-division network.**
